

Yes/no questions

There are three ways to create yes/no questions.

Hay tres maneras de crear preguntas sí/no.

1. Use inflection. Make your voice go up at the end of a sentence.
Usa inflexión. Haz que tu voz suba al final de una oración.
2. When using the verb 'to be', switch the verb and the subject.
Cuando utilice el verbo 'ser/estar', cambie el verbo y el asunto.

Example: He is eating. Is he eating? He is a student. Is he a student?

Am/Is/Are?

	singular	plural
1st person	Am I?	Are we?
2nd person	Are you?	Are you? Are you all?
3rd person	Is he? Is she?	Are they?

3. For the rest, use the verb 'to do' at the start of the sentence, before the subject.
Para el resto, utilice el verbo "hacer" al principio de la oración, antes del sujeto.
- Example: He teaches English. Does he teach English? The cat eats. Does the cat eat?

Do/does?

	singular	plural
1st person	Do I?	Do we?
2nd person	Do you?	Do you? Do you all?
3rd person	Does she? Does he?	Do they?
