Future Tense: Going to

Fill in the blank. Use the word in parentheses and the future tense using 'going to'.

1. *Are we going to visit the monument?*

Let's go visit the monument.

2. Are we going to see the sights?

Let's visit the monument. Let's go visit the monument. Let's go and visit the monument.

3. Are we going to go to the amusement park?

Let's go to the amusement park. Note: do not mark it as wrong if you put something like 'Let's go go to the amusement park' or 'Let's go and go to the amusement park'; these are not wrong sentences, but these sentences is unlikely to be used in English due to the double use of 'go'. This is true for all sentences that contain the verb 'to go'.

Nota: no lo marques como incorrecto si pones algo como 'Let's go go to the amusement park' o 'Let's go and go to the amusement park'; no se trata de sentencias erróneas, pero es poco probable que estas frases se utilicen en inglés debido al doble uso de 'go'. Esto es cierto para todas las oraciones que contienen el verbo 'go'.

4. Are we going to eat at the museum restaurant?

Let's eat at the museum restaurant. Let's go eat at the museum restaurant. Let's go and eat at the museum restaurant.

5. Are we going to go shopping at the gift shop?

Let's go shopping at the gift shop.

6. Are we going to watch a movie?

Let's watch a movie. Let's go watch a movie. Let's go and watch a movie.

7. Are we going to take a tour of the city?

Let's take a tour of the city. Let's go take a tour of the city. Let's go and take a tour of the city.

8. Are we going to visit the country?

Let's visit the country. Let's go visit the country. Let's go and visit the country.

9. Are we going to relax at the beach?

Let's relax at the beach. Let's go relax at the beach. Let's go and relax at the beach.

10. Are we going to have some fun?

Let's have some fun. Let's go have some fun. Let's go and have some fun.
