## **Denton County Winter Weather Advisory**

**Lake Dallas, TX, February 2, 2022**

### **CURRENT SITUATION**

A winter weather event is forecasted for North Texas beginning on Wednesday evening, February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022. The National Weather Service (NWS) Office in Fort Worth has issued a Winter Weather Warning for Denton County from 6pm Wednesday through 6pm Thursday.

At the time of this announcement, rain is expected to begin around 3PM this afternoon (Wednesday, Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup>) and transition into freezing rain and ice accumulation overnight. Roadway conditions are anticipated to be poor due to ice accumulation.

Please note that officials do not anticipate this event being as bad as last year's Winter Storm Uri. However, weather can be unpredictable. Also, please be advised that power outages may occur due to the severity of ice accumulation. Take all necessary steps to ensure your and your family's safety.

City of Lake Dallas Administrative Offices will close early Wednesday (February 2<sup>nd</sup>) at 3PM, will be closed all day Thursday (February 3<sup>rd</sup>) and anticipates a delayed start on Friday (February 4<sup>th</sup>). **These time closures and delays do not interrupt Police or Public Works services.**
