Denton County Winter Weather Advisory Update

Lake Dallas, TX, February 3, 2022

CURRENT SITUATION

Due to inclement weather and treacherous road conditions, City of Lake Dallas Administrative Offices will remain closed through Friday (February 4th). **These time closures and delays do not interrupt Police or Public Works services.**

Freezing temperatures, snow, sleet and rain have led to ¼ to ½ an inch of ice accumulation in some areas, which could pose an impact to electric service and localized outages.

The following emergency shelters and warming stations are available in the area:

MLK Jr. Rec Center (1300 Wilson St. Denton, TX) is open as a 24-hour emergency shelter as of 6 p.m. on Wednesday, Feb. 2. The emergency shelter will have restrooms, seating, water, pre-packaged snack food, basic sanitary items available, and will provide cots for anyone needing to remain at the shelter overnight.

Emily Fowler Central Library (502 Oakland St. Denton, TX) will remain open to serve as a warming station during regular business hours from Feb. 3-6.

Central Fire State (332 E. Hickory St. Denton, TX) is open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Salvation Army of Lewisville (206 W. Main St. Lewisville, TX) is open as an emergency shelter.
