Denton County Winter Weather Information

Friday, February 25, 2022– Today's forecast contends that we could see one last chance for wintry precipitation Saturday morning thru the afternoon. No Watches, Warnings, or Advisories are expected for this round of winter precipitation. Winter precipitation will transition to cold rain for the remainder of the day on Saturday. Main Threats (Saturday Morning):

- Icing on bridges and elevated roadways
- Ice accumulation on trees and power lines

Should you need to travel, keep the following winter driving tips in mind:

- Reduce speed and allow plenty of space between you and other vehicles.
- Avoid sharp turns and breaking suddenly.
- Stop and accelerate slowly and in second gear for better traction.
- If you vehicle begins to skid, turn your steering wheel in the opposite direction. Avoid breaking and sharp turns.
- Sand, cardboard and kitty litter can reestablish traction if you become stuck.
- Keep blankets, water, jumper cables, flashlights and a tow rope in your vehicle in the event you become stranded.
