The collection contains popular adult fiction and non-fiction, as well as some young adult crossover materials. You'll find newly published titles from well-known authors, as well as classics and independent fiction. There's also a great selection of nonfiction titles to help you learn new things, such as languages, arts and crafts, gardening, or business skills.

### How to log into Boundless

Download the **Boundless App** from iTunes, Amazon, or Google Play or open your library's Boundless URL in a browser (skip steps 1-4).



1. Tap the Boundless icon.



2. Search for your library by name or city.



3. Select your library from the drop-down list.



4. Tap on your library.



5. Enter your library card number and PIN and tap Sign In.



6. You can search for and check out a book!


