Road Projects

Bid Openings for South Shady Shores and Hundley will be December 2, 2025, and we are bringing the bid award to Council on December 11, 2025.

The Carlilse Drive project being managed by the Town of Hickory Creek is still moving forward. The Town of Hickory Creek and LCMUA are working on the engineering for the water and sewer plans that will also be in conjunction with the street paving project.

North Shady Shores (North of Swisher) the road project for that is being handled by Denton County. Bridge work should begin very soon and shortly after that begins the road construction will begin.

Ribbon Cutting for Mini-Pitches

We will be hosting an event on December 18, 2025, to celebrate the Mini Pitches project. Representatives from FIFA and the U.S. Soccer Foundation will also be in attendance as part of their Legacy Program. Additional details will be shared in the coming weeks. This will be one of the first FIFA World Cup; related events in the Metroplex, and we are proud to have it here in Lake Dallas.

American Legion and VFW


